Intro:

Ephesians 6:1-9

1. This text deals with more mundane parts of life: being a child who is obedient, being a parent who is loving, being an employee who works as for the Lord, and a boss who leads with Christ-like leadership.
2. All these things seem mundane and small but they take up the biggest part of our lives.

NEW LOOK AT THE MUNDANE

The secret in battle is not in overcoming monumental obstacles but in *mastering the mundane* matters of life. With their insatiable appetite, these “*concerns for the ordinary*”, consume the precious moments of our day. Although individually minuscule in measure, when added together, these mundane matters are weighty enough to crush the most spirited of souls. In order to navigate our way through the forest of daily duties and over the waters of incessant errands we must develop certain personal disciplines.

The fate of far more destinies have fallen victim to mundane matters than monumental obstacles. Those who learn how to *master the mundane* will discover the secret to their destiny lies within the moment.
